NOTES TO ACCOMPANY DISTRIBUTION AND SIGNING OF THE PETITION

1. We ask you to sign this hard copy petition:
- say **NO to the monorail project**

which will be presented to the House of Representatives, asking the House to ensure protection of *Te Wahipounamu* South West New Zealand World Heritage Area by preventing construction of the monorail project.

For a petition to be accepted by the House and referred to a select committee it must follow certain rules and it cannot be accepted by the House until all legal remedies have been exhausted, including by the courts or a tribunal or the Ombudsman. The petition when accepted by the House is allocated to a select committee which then decides what to do with it.

2. For the hard copy petition to be valid, although any person can sign it, it must be signed personally i.e. the signature **cannot** be photocopied, faxed, scanned, pasted or otherwise transferred onto the signature sheet. It must be original.

3. Provided the subject of the petition is within the legislative competence of the New Zealand Parliament, the nationality or place of residence of the petitioners is irrelevant. Signatories **do not** have to include their addresses and **do not** have to be New Zealand residents.

4. Simultaneously, there is an online petition:
- say **NO to the monorail project**

which can be signed electronically i.e. through online media, www.savefiordland.org.nz or our facebook page, www.facebook.com/SaveFiordland.

The online petition is being used as support to inform the Minister of Conservation Dr Nick Smith of the strength of feeling in New Zealand and the international community against the monorail proposal, in the hope of influencing his decision as to whether to grant a concession to construct a monorail in the *Te Wahipounamu* South West New Zealand World Heritage Areas of Snowdon Forest and the Fiordland National Park.

5. So the attached signature sheet with the petition on it needs to be:
downloaded, printed and then physically signed.
